AFTER VERSE 2: Jesus spoke to Paul who wrote these words in 2nd Corinthians 12:9: "MY GRACE IS SUFFICIENT FOR YOU, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Paul's response was that he -- and we -- should not WORRY about feeling DORKY -- though he didn't use THAT word! -- but instead, use that fact to show others that YES, it is the POWER OF CHRIST IN US that helps us -- *Corinthians 12:9*.
New KJV "Therefore most gladly I will rather **BOAST** in my infirmities, that the **POWER OF CHRIST** my rest upon me. I take **PLEASURE** in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs.... For when I am WEAK, then I am strong."

Song Story. This one is long. But it's uplifting.... I believe it may encourage YOU.

It takes me over an hour each way to reach my "final drafts" studio, *Valley Worship and Praise*. (God has honored me with enough songs to need 2 studios.... and provided J&T Studio when I had never even considered the fact that we were "getting behind" in recording all the great song ideas God has been providing.) To use that travel time wisely, I listen to CDs I've created containing drafts for future songs, drafts I have made in my home studio, sitting at the keyboard and "just playing" and creating loops and drumkit tracks and instrument tracks. (Sometimes rather randomly.... and they come out great with God's help! Having THE Creator for inspiration is AWE-some!)

As I listened to the home studio recording of "UNTITLED HAPPY IN C" (ok, so it's not an original song name, but it's descriptive!), I was passing an exit only 8 miles away from VwP Studio's exit. By the time I got to the correct exit, I had realized that I was singing what are now the words you hear for Verse 1, in this melody. And I was laughing and laughing with God, shaking my head at how dorky I sounded.

But then I had this idea..... God must enjoy giving us people these ideas!.....

And 1/2 hour later, I recorded what I had sung on the interstate. However, since I'd just "written" this song, I got a speck off key at the end of verse one, and I REALLY blew it at the end of verse 2, so much that I laughed and laughed. And laughed more as Claxton hit the "stop recording" button, slowly swiveled in his chair toward me, and just silently looked at me with that *raised eyebrow* he sometimes gives me that silently says with amusement, "Well, shall we try that AGAIN???"

But I enjoyed the playback so much that I decided to keep it a week to enjoy. And then decided that it just proved the song's point: We ARE rather dorky without God's empowering that He promises to those of us who ask, in Ephesians 3:20. Unlike the many true Christians who just assume God will bless us without us fervently asking. God does help.... and God deeply empowers those who deeply and humbly pray for His Ephesians 3:20-21 empowering for His Kingdom work and our living His way.

I was SO AMAZED... but not surprised, God has been so gifting.... at the idea to come up with beautiful ending music for an unplanned (by ME) verse 3. I just sat at the controller and played "anything" in the basic song key.... Now the interlude for all those "just sat and played" instrument tracks are the first **AND** final drafts.

God's grace IS sufficient in our weakness. He can use humble people who admit they are at least somewhat dorky without Him....what **an honor** that God **calls us!**
