Rev. 2:20-21, Jesus gives time to repent...For **AWHILE**...

VERSE 1 - 6/8 Swing Time

"Jesus was a great guy. We loved what He did. He fed us, made us wine at a party, healed us, raised the dead."

So we say, "HEY: *What a shame, Jesus had to start.... criticizing our simple, 'normal sins'.*" << to Chorus >>

CHORUS - 4/4 Rock Time

"Hey, we LIKED Jesus when He healed us! Loved His smiles, Comfort, words of Peace!"

"Wow, we LOVED when He fed us **fish and bread**....."

Jesus seemed a NICE guy. *WHY* did He *CHANGE??!*"

... It's our choice to REJECT Him." 2nd HALF >>

"We DON'T like Jesus a'-meddling! We enjoy all our '**little normal sins**'."

"We REJECT this meddling in our Life.

SO: It's our **choice** to **REJECT** Him."

VERSE 2 - 6/8 Swing Time

"Jesus was an awesome guy, who stood up to Pharisees. We loved His sermons, loved parables, 'til Jesus **scolded** us!"

So we say: "*What a shame, Jesus had to start.... criticizing our simple, 'normal sins'.*" << to Chorus >>

VERSE 3

That is what the people said – John 6: 66. He asks YOU, do YOU love parables, **but hate** His warnings on **SIN**? Will you Leave?

AND will YOU say: "*What a shame, Jesus had to start.... criticizing our simple, 'normal sins'.*" ?? << to Scriptures, then 2nd half of Chorus >>

SCRIPTURE after verse 3 during first half of CHORUS. Then sing 2nd half.

John 5:14 Afterward Jesus found in the temple in the Temple the lame man whom he had healed, Jesus said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."

John 6:26, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled."... About 30 verses later, we read in

John 6:60-1: "...many of His disciples...said, 'This is a hard saying; who can understand it?' When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained about this, He said to them, 'Does this **offend** you?' **John 6:66**> From that time many of His disciples went back & walked with Him no more."
