LAST READING -- From the very beginning, Matthew 1: 23, God's promise was, "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name *Immanuel*, which is translated, **God is with us.**" From Matthew 28: 20, Jesus was speaking when He was speaking to them and to all of us, to teach others to "observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, [even] to the end of the age." Amen. Hebrews 13: 5, Do no covet. Be content with such things as you have. "*For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."*" Hebrews 13:5.

Song Story. As for many songs from God -- I was *just sitting* at my keyboard "playing around" - *any notes*-- one day. I liked this melody, and saved the project as "**Untitled in F Pretty**" (not the same as in C Pretty, which I used for Psalm 119 MEM 97).
