Song Story. Awoke at 1:30 A.M. during a thunderstorm while I was camping in my van during SUKKOT, the Feast of Tabernacles that God lists as a calendar requirement time for resting & gathering to praise Him with the fellowship of believers. (Leviticus 23:44, Deuteronomy 16:13-16, Zechariah 14).... First played around with chord on my guitar to try to distract myself from the winds hitting the van – and the tall pine tree above me. Tried to sleep after finishing the melody... no success as the storm continued. So, by lamplight in my van “nest, I thumbed through my Bible looking for psalms that I had not yet written music for... and quickly was guided to this one that easily fell into the music design.... a SUPER cool gift from our Creator God!...
