VERSE 1

Song Story. I had sketched out the first verse's lyrics for this Psalm 19, 2-1/2 years earlier, but never wrote out any music. On 10 Oct 2013, someone sent me a text message who I'd just told sure, I could play a few of my psalms songs for the Shabbat worship service 2 days later. I invited him to pick out which psalms. I forgot to mention that my invitation was for those already written, so he hadn't checked the website database when he asked for Psalm 19, the focus of the week's lesson. So I prayed. And God provided. I recorded it at Studio #2 (wrong week for Studio #1) on 10/11, and we worshiped with it on 10/12. Here 'tis. God's.
