VERSE 1

Psalm 81, **God is willing** to lift burdens and to free Us.

- Psalm 81, when in distress, we call to Yahweh*, God, Who answers us who Honor Him...... Follow Him.....
- Psalm 81, God is Willing to protect ALL who honor Him: God Named Yahweh. ALL who honor Him: God Named Yahweh.

VERSE 2

Psalm 81, if we won't listen, will **NOT** submit to The LORD of all:

He's willing to <u>LET</u> our stubborn hearts to *leave*, to *reject* God, go our own way, to NOT honor Him...... to NOT follow Him.....

Psalm 81, God has <u>NOT</u> promised a thing to ALL who IGNORE Him: God Named Yahweh..... to ALL who IGNORE Him: God Named Yahweh.

<u>Scripture 1</u> Psalm 81 tells us how God- Yahweh (YHWH) is WILLING: Psalm 81: 6-7 & 16, The LORD YHWH speaking to His people in Egypt-- and to us all:

"I removed his shoulder from the burden; his hands were freed from the baskets. You called in trouble, & I delivered you; [I] *would* have fed them also with the finest of wheat; And with honey from the rock I *would* have satisfied you." That's GOD through the Psalmist Asaph speaking to those who ignored Him even <u>after all His gifts of blessings</u>. 2nd Peter 3:9 "The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, <u>not willing</u> that any should perish but *<IS WILLING>* that <u>ALL</u> should <u>COME</u> to repentance." 2nd Peter 3:9 + <u>ALL</u> through His scriptures.

** REPEAT CHORUS and VERSE 2 (only)

Scripture 2 In Hebrews 6:4-6, God named YHWH warns us... <see **pg 2**>... In Malachi 4:2, the LORD of hosts named YHWH promises, **"To you who fear My Name, the Son of Righteous-ness shall come with healing in his wings."** The robes of men of Israel had tassels that were called "wings". The woman who touched Jesus's hem on his robe KNEW this prophecy-- and The Messiah healed her-- Jesus who God had prophesied 400 years earlier. The end of Mat-thew 23 tells of the LORD's deep love and calling to EVERYone, even those who have rejected Him: "O how often I wanted to gather you together as a hen gathered her chicks under his wings- but <u>YOU</u> were NOT WILLING. **GOD is WILLING** for ALL to come to Him for **SALVATION**.

SCRIPTURES for reading 2

Hebrews 6 Verses 4 to 6 -- New King James Version

1 "Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this we will do if God permits.

For it is impossible for those who were <u>once</u> enlightened, and <u>have</u> tasted the heavenly gift, and <u>have</u> become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and <u>have</u> tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they fall away [by their own personal choice to reject God] to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God,

and put Him to an open shame.

7 For the earth which drinks in the rain that often comes upon it, and bears herbs useful for those by whom it is cultivated, receives blessing from God; 8 but if it bears thorns and briers, it is rejected and near to being cursed, whose end is to be burned. 9 But, beloved, we are confident of better things concerning you, yes, things that accompany salvation, though we speak in this manner. 10 For <u>God is not unjust to forget your work</u> and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister. 11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full

assurance of hope until the end, 12 that you do not become sluggish *<careless, caring less>*, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises."
