SPOKEN CONCLUSION

ISAIAH 55: 6 TO 9. "My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts," says the LORD. "And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine."
-- Isaiah 55.

God clearly tells us the main reason why He had to bring the child to himself through death Portions from Second Samuel 12:

11

"Thus says the LORD: 'Behold, I will raise up adversity against you from your own house....'"

12

'For you did [it] secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel, before the sun.' "

13

So David said to Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD."

And Nathan said to David, "The LORD also has put away your sin; you shall not die. "However, because by this deed you have given great

occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also [who is] born to you shall surely die." -- Second Samuel 12.

To blaspheme is to speak irreverently against God.

God shows His holiness and LOGIC as well as His love.

People would have **mocked** saying,

who is this God who lets David commit murder? This is NOT a just God who will condemn us but NOT His precious David.

Or they would have **mocked God** saying, "hey, David's God has no POWER to do anything about David murdering."

Or would have said, "David's God is a fake."

Song Story.

A lot of research went into this song. Concordance used a lot!

A lot of review went into this song --- a few "hard-sayings-Bible-studying Christ-followers who know I want honesty" reviewed the lyrics for me. While praying.

A lot of prayers for wisdom (James 1:5) goes into **EVERY** song I develop for LORD God, *for one of my deepest awarenesses is that I SHALL drift into "The Error of human teachings" instead of God's Truth if I depend on my own feelings rather than praying for God's wisdom as I craft HIS Bible words (not just "ideas") into songs.*

The song idea itself is The Holy Spirit's guiding, I confidently declare. Persons for whom I cared deeply kept telling me they questioned the ability to trust the Bible words about God's compassion when He would kill an innocent baby like David's.
